Lidia Schapira, MD PROFESSOR OF MEDICINE- ONCOLOGY



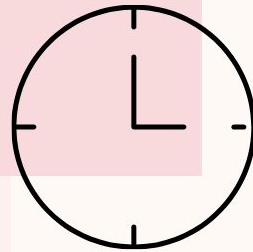

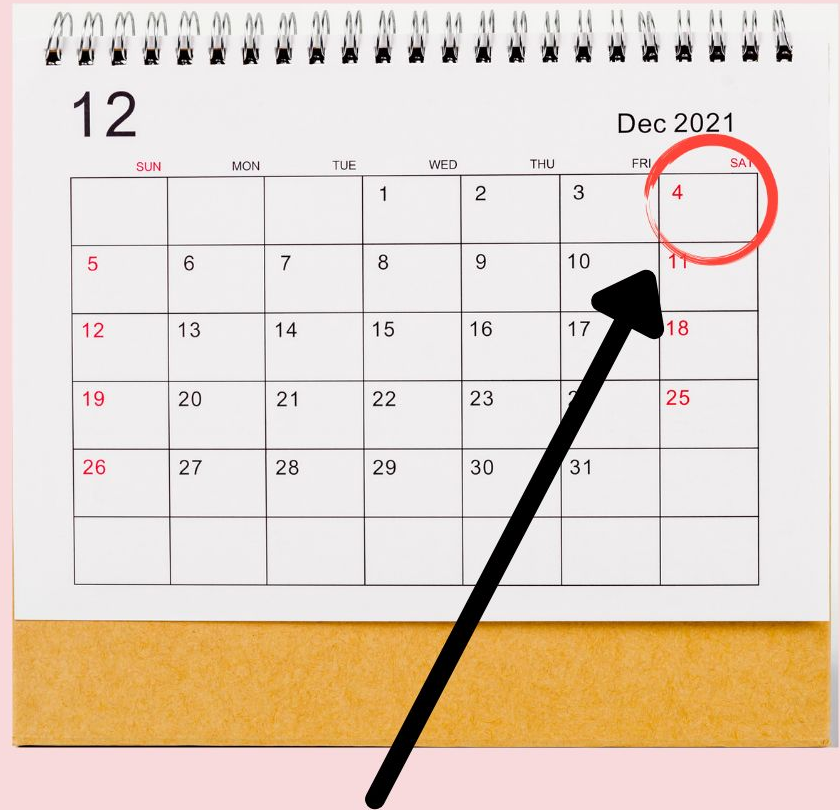
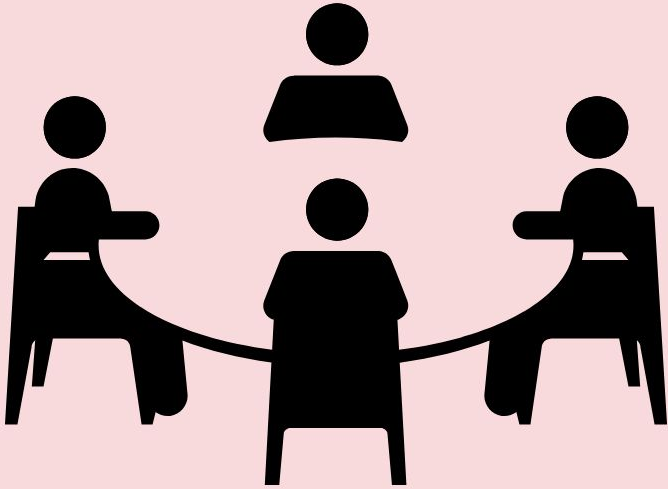
Telling her story...
