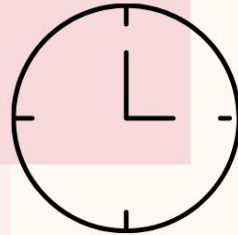


GRANT M. SMITH, MD

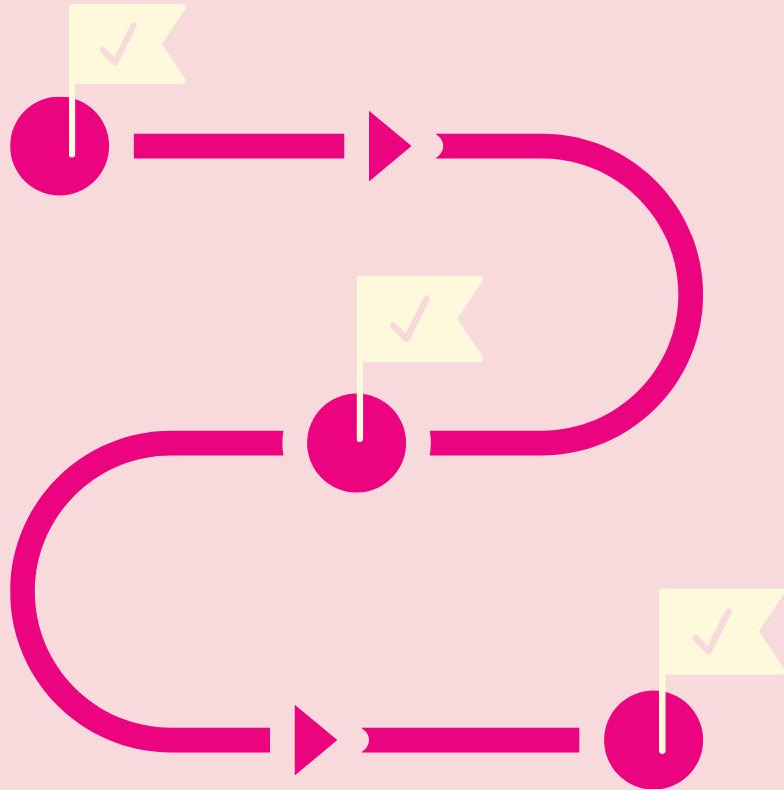
Hospice and Palliative Medicine

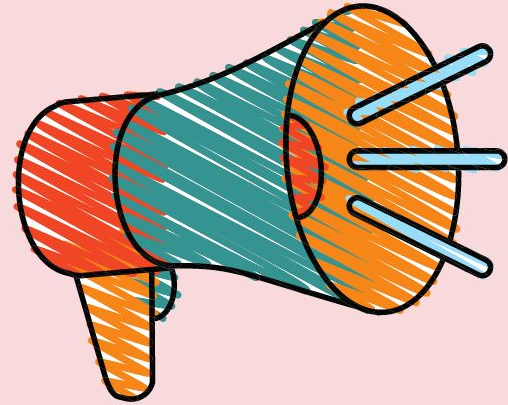
